

Westminster Cathedral – A case study



Westminster Cathedral is the home of the Catholic Church in England. Located in the heart of London, the Cathedral campus is extensive including the Cathedral, a retail shop, the Cathedral's administration buildings, a music school and private residencies for senior clergy and guests.

The management of security within a campus like Westminster Cathedral is a complex business. The Cathedral needs to be open to both visitors and worshippers and yet provide a secure environment for the residents, staff and students of the music school.

Instrom was initially appointed by the Cathedral Management to undertake a review of the security provision at the campus, with particular emphasis on the access control system which was no longer deemed fit for purpose.
